Just five years after the end of the Second World War (and seventy years ago in June), another war began when the tanks of North Korea rolled across the 38th parallel, driving South Korean forces into headlong retreat. This is the story of how South Korea survived with the support of the United Nations and a UN-sanctioned force led by the United States. The was the first 'hot war' of the new Cold War era and, as such, set the pattern for much that followed, particularly in Vietnam.
